EDUCATION



A private, Catholic, coeducational college north of Pittsburgh founded by the

Sisters of Divine Providence in 1963, La Roche welcomes students of all religions, ethnic origins and talents. Undergraduates may choose from more than 50 majors, including the top 10 majors most in demand among today's college students. La Roche combines a quality educational experience with clubs, athletics, social and community volunteer activities, spiritual well-being and more to prepare students for life in a constantly changing global society.



Founded by the Sisters of Divine Providence in 1926, the Alpha School is a private, Catholic, coeducational school located on the Sisters' 40-acre campus north of Pittsburgh. Voted one of the 25 most innovative

Catholic schools in the country, Alpha School provides outstanding instruction for students in kindergarten through eighth grade in fundamental skills, while encouraging original thinking, intellectual curiosity, moral growth and creative self-expression.



Sacred Heart was founded in 1947 by the Sisters of Divine Providence as a private, Catholic, coeducational school for students in preschool through twelfth grade. The school's expan-

sive and beautiful 120-acre campus is located in Kingston, Massachusetts. In the tradition of the Sisters of Divine Providence, the school seeks to develop a community of faith that encourages students to act with compassion, to work for a just society and to pursue opportunities to develop and share their God-given talents in service to society.

SOCIAL SERVICES



Founded by the Sisters of Divine Providence in 1989, La Posada Providencia—Spanish for the Inn of Providence—is located in South Texas. A 24/7 emergency shelter for immigrants, asy-

lum seekers and asylees, La Posada provides safe shelter, food, local transportation and supportive services to help clients take the necessary steps to achieve self-sufficiency and responsible integration into U.S. culture. Since its founding, La Posada has assisted more than 8,000 people from over 70 countries.



Established in 1994 by the Sisters of Divine Providence, Providence Connections is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to strengthen families and enrich lives. The center serves more than 350 Pittsburgh-area families and 400 children through child care services, before

and after school care, family support, parent and adult education, in-home visitation and family counseling.



Sponsored by the Sisters of Divine Providence since 1993, Room at the Inn is

one of only three emergency shelter providers in the St. Louis County Continuum of Care. The shelter helps more than 200 people each year, including single mothers with their children, single women and two-parent or single-father families. The ministry collaborates with more than 50 interfaith groups to make needed services available, including case management to help clients identify and correct the causes for their homelessness; physical and mental health evaluations; substance abuse evaluations and counseling; domestic abuse counseling; life-skills classes, including financial management, parenting and job skills; and housing placement assistance.

RETREATS & SPIRITUALITY

Kearns Spirituality Center

Located north of Pittsburgh on the beautiful campus of the Sisters of Divine Providence, Kearns Spirituality Center is a Catholic retreat center sponsored by the Sisters since 1983. Kearns invites people of all faiths searching for a deeper meaning in their lives to experience an environment dedicated to the renewal and revitalization of the human spirit. Programs in spirituality and holistic health are just a sampling of what Kearns offers to individuals, hosted groups and meeting groups of up to 250. Additional features at Kearns include a woodland reflection trail, a labyrinth for prayerful walking, a meditation garden, a spirituality library, 27 guest rooms, state-of-the-art audio/visual equipment, Wi-Fi, a fully equipped kitchen and food service.
